NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 8th September, 2009

G.S.R. 647(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (f) of sub-section (2) of Section 87 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 and in supersession of the Department of Information Technology, Office of Controller of Certifying Authorities (Group 'A' Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2003, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the Gazetted and Non-Gazetted posts in the Office of Controller of Certifying Authorities, a statutory body under the administrative control of the Department of Information Technology, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Department of Information Technology, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Controller of Certifying Authorities, Gazetted and Non-Gazetted posts Recruitment Rules, 2009.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Application.**—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (I) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications, etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 14 of the aforesaid Schedule.

5. **Disqualification.**—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to any of the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.**—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Saving.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 16th August, 2013

G.S.R. 566(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (f) of sub-section (2) of section 87 of the Information Technology Act, 2000 (21 of 2000) and in supersession of the Department of Information Technology, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Controller of Certifying Authorities, Gazetted and Non-Gazetted posts Recruitment Rules, 2009, in so far as they relate to the post of Director (Finance and Administration), except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the Central Government hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Director (Finance and Administration) in the office of Controller of Certifying Authorities, a statutory body under the Department of Electronics and Information Technology, Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.— (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology, Department of Electronics and Information Technology, Controller of Certifying Authorities, Director (Finance and Administration), Recruitment Amendment Rules, 2013.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of posts, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.—The number of the said post, its classification and the pay band or grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age-limit, other qualifications, etc.—The method of recruitment, age-limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualifications. — No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.—where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age-limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other backward Classes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
